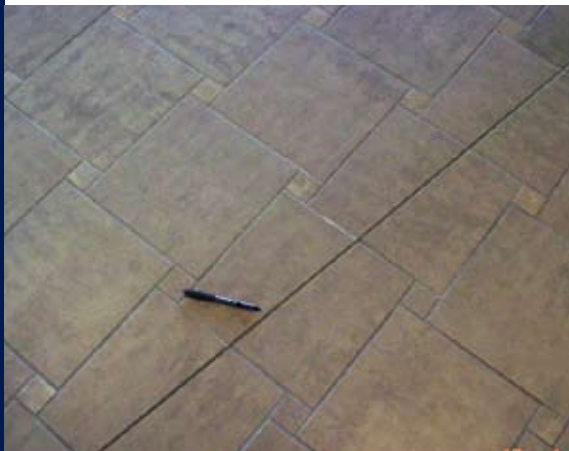

Recognized Industry Consultant

NTCA frequently receives inquiries from the tile and construction industry and from consumers requesting professional expertise both prior to and after installations. The Association has chosen to address this situation by developing a list of qualified individuals that meet a range of criteria and by making this list available on its website.

“Our intent was to give someone inquiring about consultants a list of those who were recognized by our organization and thereby allowing them to choose a consultant from that list that met their needs professionally, geographically, etc.,” said Nyle Wadford. Wadford worked to develop this list and set of criteria along with John Cox, Ed Strickland, Jim Carlin and Bob Brown as part of the NTCA Standard and Methods Committee, led by James Woelfel. The criteria were approved by the Board of Directors in fall 2007.

The Standards and Methods Committee will review all applications for approval. The cost to apply for the Recognized Consultants designation is \$500 for the initial application fee. Applications that aren't approved and need to be resubmitted require an additional \$250 fee; annual renewals are \$250.

Recognized Consultants must meet the following criteria:

___ A minimum of 15 years as a tile contractor

___ If not a tile contractor, then applicants must have a background in architecture and/or engineering with a direct relationship to the ceramic tile industry.

___ Applicants must provide a resume with letters of recommendation from the ceramic tile industry, architects, distributors, manufacturers and consulting clients.

___ Recognition must be renewed on a yearly basis.

Active participation in educational seminars and events such as Coverings, Total Solutions, NTCA Workshop and seminars, CTEF programs, ANSI and TCA Handbook Committee meetings is encouraged and will be factored into consideration of recognition.
